Main targets:

Expected results:

- At least 240 local and regional policy makers and businesses and 1000 young people to participate in various training courses and events
- Development of concrete simple tool for municipalities, businesses and schools? reduce energy consumption
- Establish an international meeting place and platform

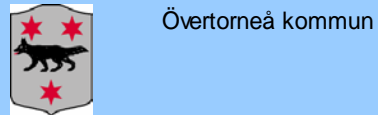
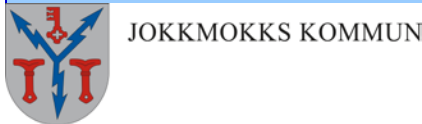


Climate and Energy Catalogue of Measures For Communities in the North
